New Business

The single item under new business was the review and withdrawal of Mr. Kenneth Hill, Democratic candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, District 4, pursuant to S.C. Code of Laws 7-11-50, 55. Chairman Wells advised the Commissioners, per S.C. Code of Laws §7-11-50 and 55, parties may hold a special primary if the withdrawn candidate resigns for a, "…legitimate nonpolitical reason."; and that the board needed to determine whether the affidavit received from Mr. Hill qualifies as such.

After some discussion, Mr. Moseley made a motion to find that Mr. Hill did not withdraw for a nonpolitical reason, Mr. Edler seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Chairman Wells voted in favor of the motion. Ms. Day and Ms. McCall voted against the motion. The majority ruled and the motion passed that Mr. Hill did not withdraw for a nonpolitical reason.

With no further business to discuss, Ms. Day made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ms. McCall. The motion was passed unanimously.
