# **Approval of Minutes**

The first item of business was the approval of minutes for the October 19, 2022 (SEC) meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Ms. Day, seconded by Mr. Edler. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.

# **New Business**

The single item under new business was the November 8, 2022, General Election debriefing. Mr. Knapp stated of the 3,379,089 eligible voters, 1,718,626 cast votes which represented a statewide participation rate of 50.86%. He further stated the total of early voting and absentee votes before election day was 619,563 or 36.0% of the total votes cast.

## **Old Business**

Agency FY 2023-2024 budget request update was the first item under old business. Mr. Knapp advised there was no update on the agency's request.

The second item under old business was the election infrastructure security update. Mr. Knapp stated the agency continues to work with its federal, state, and private security partners to protect South Carolina's election infrastructure.



# **Executive Session**

Chairman Wells asked for a motion to go into executive session to receive and discuss legal advice. Ms. McCall made said motion, seconded by Ms. Day. The motion passed unanimously.
