Judge Shedd called the meeting of the State Board of Canvassers (SBC) to order. Director Knapp advised that all notices of the meeting had been posted as required by the Freedom of Information Act.

Chairman Shedd stated that the first order of business was the certification of the results of the Statewide Democratic and Republican Primaries held on Tuesday, June 11, 2024. Ms. Day made a motion to certify the results of the Statewide Democratic and Republican primaries. It was seconded by Mr. Edler. The motion was unanimous.

The second order of business was to order the mandatory recount for the Republican State House of Representative District 28 Primary in Greenville County. The recount will be conducted beginning at 3:24 p.m. Ms. Day moved to order the designated recounts for State House of Representative District 28. Ms. McCall seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous vote and the recount was ordered.

Chairman Shedd then called for a recess of the meeting until the recount was completed. Ms. McCall made a motion to recess the meeting. Ms. Day seconded the motion, and the meeting went into recess.

At 8:30 p.m., Chairman Shedd reconvened the State Board of Canvassers meeting. Ms. McCall made a motion to certify the recount for Republican State House of Representative District 28 in Greenville County. The motion was seconded by Ms. Day. The motion passed by unanimous vote and the recount was certified.

Chairman Shedd then called for a runoff to be ordered for the following offices:

- Republican U.S. House of Representatives District 3 in Abbeville, Anderson, Edgefield, Greenville, Greenwood, Laurens, McCormick, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, and Saluda Counties.
- Republican State House of Representatives District 9 in Anderson County.
- Republican State House of Representatives District 28 in Greenville County.
- Republican State Senate District 6 in Greenville County.
- Republican State Senate District 35 in Kershaw, Lee, Richland, and Sumer Counties.
- Democratic State Senate District 35 in Kershaw, Lee, Richland, and Sumter Counties.
- Republican State Senate District 26 in Calhoun, Lexington, and Richland Counties.
- Republican State Senate District 23 in Lexington County.
- Democratic State Senate District 22 in Richland County.
- Republican State House of Representatives District 34 in Spartanburg County.
- Republican State Senate District 12 in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties.
- Republican State Senate District 10 in Greenwood, Lexington, and Saluda Counties.
- Democratic State House of Representatives District 93 in Calhoun, Lexington, and Orangeburg Counties.

Mr. Edler made a motion to order the runoffs, seconded by Mr. Moseley. The motion was approved unanimously, and the runoffs were ordered.

A motion to adjourn was made by Chairman Shedd and seconded by Ms. Day. There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by unanimous vote at 8:37 p.m.
