

**PREP** for the **POLLS**

2024 General Election November 5

Register by the Deadline

- You must register by **Sunday, October 6** to vote in the General Election.
 - The last day to register in person is **Friday, October 4**.
- Mailed applications will be accepted if postmarked by **Monday, October 7**.
- Make sure your voter registration is current by checking your registration information at [scVOTES.gov](https://scvotes.gov).
 - If you have moved from one county to another, you must register in your new county to be eligible to vote.
 - If you've moved within your county or changed your name recently, update your information before Election Day to help ensure a smoother voting experience.

Check your Sample Ballot and Get a Photo ID

- Educate yourself on the candidates and issues by checking your sample ballot at [scVOTES.gov](https://scvotes.gov).
- Make sure you have one of the following Photo IDs: SC Driver's License, SC DMV ID Card, SC Voter Registration Card with Photo, Federal Military ID, or US Passport.
 - If you do not have one of the Photo IDs, make your voting experience fast and easy by getting a free one from the DMV or your county elections office.

You're halfway there, now pick how you want to vote!

Vote Early

- Any voter can vote early at any early voting center in their county during the early voting period. Go to an early voting center in your county, present your Photo ID, and vote using the voting system like you would at your polling place on Election Day.
 - The early voting period for the General Election starts on **Monday, October 21 and ends Saturday, November 2** (Closed Sunday, October 27).
 - Early voting centers are open **8:30 a.m.- 6:00 p.m.** during the early voting period.
- Visit [scVOTES.gov](https://scvotes.gov) to find early voting locations in your county.
- Don't forget to bring your Photo ID.

Vote Absentee

- Qualified voters can vote absentee by mail. An example of a qualified voter could be a person with a physical disability or someone who is age 65 or older.
 - To vote absentee by mail, get your application by contacting your county elections office.

- Vote at your polling place on Election Day. Polls are open **7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.**
