AN IN-DEPTH REVIEW OF HORRY COUNTY'S BALLOT RECONCILIATION WORKSHEETS FROM THE NOVEMBER 2022 GENERAL ELECTION

For the 2022 General Election, Horry County's ballot reconciliation worksheets were generally incomplete and unreconciled. Specifically:

- 6% of the worksheets were not available for review.
- 56% of the worksheets were completed, and 38% were partially completed.
- 14% of the worksheets were reconciled, and 80% were not.

Of the worksheets that were partially completed, this was partly due to the lack of a requirement from the State Election Commission to fill every field, even if zero. The remaining incomplete worksheets were missing numbers greater than zero. For the worksheets that did not reconcile, this is primarily due to not counting and verifying blank ballot cards; not accounting for unused ballot cards; data entry errors; and undercounting, overcounting, or double counting voters checked in. Adequately completing and reconciling the ballot reconciliation worksheet will give greater assurance that all valid ballots cast have been included in the election results.
