

MILITARY & OVERSEAS CITIZENS

Those serving overseas have the ability to participate fully in our democracy without significant barriers or obstacles. Special services are provided to assist military and overseas citizens' participation in elections.



STEP 1: REGISTER TO VOTE

- Register or check the status of your voter registration at **scVOTES.gov**.
- You can also register by downloading and completing the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) from the Federal Voting Assistance Program at **FVAP.gov**.



STEP 2: REQUEST YOUR BALLOT

- Download the FPCA from **FVAP.gov**.
 - Fill it out and check the box to indicate how you want to receive your ballot.
 - Submit the FPCA to your county voter registration office by postal mail, fax, or email.
- Visit **scVOTES.gov** to check the status of your requested ballot and view your ballot ahead of time.



STEP 3: CAST YOUR VOTE AND SUBMIT YOUR BALLOT

- **Return your ballot as soon as possible.**
- Your ballot must be returned to your county voter registration office no later than 7:00 p.m. Eastern Time on the day of the election.
