## AN IN-DEPTH REVIEW OF COLLETON COUNTY'S BALLOT RECONCILIATION WORKSHEETS FROM THE NOVEMBER 2022 GENERAL ELECTION

For Colleton County's ballot reconciliation worksheets from the November 2022 General Election, 67% were completed, 33% were partially completed, 78% were reconciled, and 22% were not reconciled. Issues found on the county's worksheets involve partial completion due to the lack of a requirement from the State Election Commission to complete all fields, even if zero; inadequate emphasis on accounting for handmarked paper ballots; and electronic pollbook data issues. Emphasizing hand-marked paper ballot accountability in hands-on ballot reconciliation worksheet trainings and verifying electronic pollbook totals will likely resolve these issues. Adequately completing and reconciling the ballot reconciliation worksheets for each polling location may give greater assurance that the results include all valid ballots cast.




