

Request to Make Voter Registration Inactive

While South Carolina does not delete voter registration records, voters may request to have their registration status changed to inactive. This form serves as an official written request to make that change.

Once submitted, the South Carolina State Election Commission will update the voter's record to inactive, removing it from active voter lists and making it unavailable for online lookup. After this change, the voter will no longer be eligible to vote and must submit a new registration application to regain eligibility.

Instructions:

Only the registered voter may complete this form. Complete all required fields and sign the form. Submit the completed form to the South Carolina State Election Commission or your county voter registration office.
