AN IN-DEPTH REVIEW OF CHARLESTON COUNTY'S BALLOT RECONCILIATION WORKSHEETS FROM THE NOVEMBER 2022 GENERAL

For the November 2022 General Election, 79% of Charleston County's ballot reconciliation worksheets were completed, and 21% were reconciled. Of the 21% of worksheets that were partially completed, this was likely due to the lack of a requirement from the State Election Commission to fill every field, even if zero. Since the election, the county has provided in-depth ballot reconciliation worksheet training to its poll clerks that details the entire worksheet as well as hands-on training exercises. Additionally, the county reviews these worksheets with clerks, requiring explanations for any imbalances on the worksheet. Adequately completing and reconciling the ballot reconciliation worksheets for each polling location may give greater assurance that the results include all valid ballots cast.
