
AN IN-DEPTH REVIEW OF OCONEE COUNTY'S BALLOT RECONCILIATION WORKSHEETS FROM THE NOVEMBER 2022 GENERAL ELECTION

For the November 2022 General Election, 78% of Oconee County's ballot reconciliation worksheets were completed, and 48% were reconciled. On the worksheets that were partially completed, this was due to the lack of a requirement from the State Election Commission to fill every field, even if zero. For the 52% of Oconee County's worksheets that were not reconciled, this was due to not counting blank ballot cards, not accounting for unused hand-marked paper ballots, and paper poll list issues. Adequately completing and reconciling these worksheets for each polling location may give greater assurance that all valid ballots were included in the election results.
