Wooten confirmed there were no issues or irregularities reported, and no recounts would be necessary.

Chairman Shedd opened the floor to discussion or questions. With no further discussion, Commissioner Edler motioned to certify en masse, seconded by Chairman Shedd. The motion passed unanimously.

Interim Director Wooten informed the Commission the State Election Commission may provide comment on the Department of Justice Memorandum of Understanding at the next scheduled Commission meeting on January 21.

Commissioner Day asked whether questions could be submitted in advance of the meeting. Chairman Shedd stated the discussion would be more appropriate after a formal proposal is presented to the Commission. It was noted that Commissioners may discuss the matter

individually with Interim Director Wooten. Interim Director Wooten clarified the Commission has not agreed to any terms at this time.

Interim Director Wooten provided an update on the upcoming State House District 98 Special Election scheduled for January 6 and noted the State Board of Canvassers would meet shortly thereafter to certify the election results.
