IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ONE OF THESE PHOTO IDS:

Make your voting experience as fast and easy as possible by getting a photo ID from the DMV or your county voter registration and elections office.

IF YOU FORGET TO BRING YOUR PHOTO ID TO THE POLLING PLACE:

You may vote a provisional ballot that will count only if you show your Photo ID to the county voter registration and elections office prior to certification of the election (usually Thursday or Friday after the election).
