

VOTING MORE THAN ONCE IS A FELONY

Pursuant to S.C. Code §7-13-25(K).

Upon conviction, a person must be fined not less than one thousand dollars nor more than five thousand dollars and imprisoned not more than five years.

Election misconduct includes, but is not limited to:

- Voting fraudulently or trying to vote fraudulently
- Helping someone vote fraudulently
- Voting more than once
- Pretending to be another voter
