Early voting will begin at 8:30 a.m., Wednesday, June 17 and conclude on Thursday, June 18, 2026.
Polls will be closed on Friday, June 19, 2026, Juneteenth, as it is a federal holiday.

Runoffs will be held on Tuesday, June 23, 2026, with polls opening at 7 a.m. and closing at 7 p.m.

Discussed possibility of protests and post-election audit process.

With no further business, the meeting went into recess, anticipating reconvening via teleconference.

The SBC reconvened at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 13, 2026, with Vice Chairman Moseley noting a quorum was present and the purpose of the meeting was to certify the recount from Friday, June 12, 2026.

Vice Chairman Moseley made a motion to certify the Democratic and Republican Primary Results and recount results, and further that the runoff elections should proceed. Commissioner Stringer seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
