**Adoption of Proposed Agenda**

Chairman Bolchoz moved to adopt the agenda for the meeting. Commissioner Stringer seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

**Statewide Primary Runoff Results**

Director Belangia informed the board that the purpose of the meeting was to certify the statewide primary runoff results from Tuesday, June 23, 2026. Belangia reminded the commissioners that all canvass sheets must be initialed and signed before reviewing the winners in both the Republican and Democratic runoffs. The Director also stated that no recounts were necessary.

Director Belangia confirmed the Commissioners had the official Democratic Primary Runoff results before them then requested a motion to certify the results. Chairman Bolchoz approved the motion, seconded by Commissioner Day. The Democratic Primary Runoff results were unanimously approved. Director Belangia reminded everyone to initial and sign canvass sheets.

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The Republican Primary Runoff results were presented for certification. Chairman Bolchoz moved to certify the results, seconded by Commissioner Moseley. The Republican Primary Runoff results were unanimously approved.

**Enhanced Audit Report**

Director Belangia informed the commissioners that an official copy of the Enhanced Audit Report would be sent to each, confirming the accuracy of the tabulation and all votes cast.

Identified separately in the audit, twelve voters in Bamberg County were issued incorrect hand-marked paper ballots. Director Belangia explained that this resulted in a protest before the South Carolina Democratic Party Executive Committee. The Committee voted to uphold the election, determining that the 12 ballots did not affect the outcome.

Upon adjournment, Chairman Bolchoz asked that Commissioners be available for a meeting on July 15, 2026.
