Call to Order

Chairman Bolchoz called the State Board of Canvassers (SBC) meeting to order at 11:01 am. on August 14, 2026, noting a quorum was present and all notices of the meeting were posted as required by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Adoption of Proposed Agenda

Chairman Bolchoz moved to adopt the agenda for the meeting. Commissioner Edler seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Statewide Primary Results

Director Belangia informed the board that the purpose of the meeting was to certify the statewide U.S. Senate Special Republican Party Primary results from Tuesday, August 11, 2026. Results indicate that the top two candidates were Ralph Norman and Darline Graham, with no recount necessary. Commissioners were reminded to sign and return all canvassers sheets upon certification of results.

The U.S. Senate Special Republican Party Primary results were presented for certification. Commissioner Stringer moved to certify the results, seconded by Chairman Bolchoz. The Republican Primary results were unanimously approved.

With no further discussion, Chairman Bolchoz announced the next meeting would be held on Friday, August 28, 2026, following the U.S. Senate Special Republican Party Primary runoff on Tuesday, August 25, 2026. The meeting will combine the State Election Commission and State Board of Canvassers.

Chairman Bolchoz made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Day.

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
